Short Courses and Seminars

In 2013, the Society organised the following main short courses and workshops.

Geological Investigations Short Course, 30-31 January 2013

This two-day short course was organised by Society for Rock Mechanics & Engineering Geology in collaboration with the Graz University of Technology, Austria. The course dealt with rock

engineering problems for underground structures. Prof. Wulf Schubert and Prof. Kurt Klima conducted the course at the Nanyang Technological University. It was attended by 33 participants.

Safe and Efficient Blasting (SEB) Course for Underground Tunnelling and Applications, 7-8 March 2013

This two-day short course was organised by SRMEG with the support of Housing and Development Board, Singapore. The objective of this course was to provide participants with a greater understanding of the requirements of drilling and blasting in an underground environment. It was held at the HDB Centre of Building Research and conducted by 4 speakers from Orica Singapore – Mr. Martin Adam, Mr. Ajay Chaplot, Mr. Nathaniel Labuson and Mr. Rohan Stevens; and Mr. Willie San Pedro from Asia Tunnelling & Construction Pte Ltd. The total attendance was 50.

Workshop on Engineering Geology, 28 May 2013

This one-day workshop was organised by SRMEG with the support of the Geotechnical Society of Singapore, and developed as a follow-up to our popular Workshop on Singapore Geology held in 2010, 2011 & 2012. It was held at NUSS Kent Ridge Guild House. The speakers were Dr. Zhou Yingxin and Dr. Cai Jun Gang. It was attended by 31 participants.

Our committee member, Dr. Zhou Yingxin, who is the Vice President for Asia in the International Society for Rock Mechanics (ISRM), attended the 2nd Indonesian National Geomechanics Workshop and Seminar held in Bandung, Indonesia (August 2013), and the ISRM Council Meeting 2013 and EUROCK 2013 held in Wroclaw, Poland (September 2013).

Dr He Lei (NTU) attended Eurock 2013, where he received the first runner-up prize for ISRM Rocha Medal for his work based on his PhD thesis "Three dimensional numerical manifold method and rock engineering applications".

IAEG Activities

Our Honorary Secretary, Prof. Louis Wong, represented SRMEG at the International Symposium & 9th Asian Regional Conference of IAEG and the 2013 Council Meeting held in Beijing, China (September 2013).
